It introduces an additional 90 seats, bringing the total lounge capacity to 216. Guests will enter through a unified lounge entrance that connects both the original YYC Aspire Transborder Lounge and the newly expanded Aspire WestJet Garden Lounge. While WestJet passengers enjoy priority access, the lounge remains open to all travelers—regardless of airline—offering the opportunity to purchase entry and experience elevated comfort before their flight.

In 2024, Swissport International AG provided best-in-class airport ground services for some 247 million airline passengers (2023: 232 million), welcomed 5.9 million lounge guests (2023: 5.7 million), and handled roughly five million tons of air freight (2023: 4.7 million) at 117 cargo centers. Several of its warehouses have been certified for pharmaceutical logistics by IATA's CEIV Pharma and by the British MHRA. At the end of December 2024, the world's leader in airport ground services and air cargo handling, with currently around 62,000 employees, was active at 279 airports in 45 countries on six continents.
