MEDIA RELEASE SWISSPORT OPENS ASPIRE CRYSTAL LOUNGE IN THE NEW EAST WING AT GENEVA AIRPORT

Swissport is opening its second lounge at Geneva International Airport on 1 February 2022. Located in the new East Wing of the airport, the new ASPIRE Crystal Lounge will be open daily from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. It is accessible to all passengers for an admission fee of 45 Swiss francs.

Built with natural materials such as stone and wood, the ASPIRE Crystal Lounge welcomes passengers in a sleek and serene environment. The textures and colors of the interior immerse visitors in a mountainous setting, while large windows provide views of the Swiss Alpine peaks across Lake Geneva.

The ASPIRE Crystal Lounge is open to all passengers daily from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The admission fee is 45 francs. Swiss International Air Lines First Class passengers & HON members, Priority Pass and DragonPass members as well as members of the ASPIRE network have access to the lounge free of charge. The new lounge offers a broad range of catering and refreshment services as well as a fully equipped business area where comfortable and stimulating décor provide a working environment that promotes concentration and creativity.

"With this opening, we expand the ASPIRE Lounge offering in Switzerland from 5 to 6 lounges at the airports in Zurich (3), Geneva (2) and Basel (1), making us the largest airline-independent lounge provider in Switzerland and Europe," says Samuel Hunziker, Vice President Global Lounge of Swissport. "Our new Aspire Crystal Lounge in the East Wing of Geneva Airport invites long-haul passengers to relax, enjoy and work. We are confident it will delight our guests and contribute to the attractiveness of Geneva Airport."

The ASPIRE Crystal Lounge joins a steadily growing list of 60 Swissport lounges at 35 airports in 20 countries, welcoming more than 5 million passengers per year. New ASPIRE lounges are opening soon in Perth, Australia; Kilimanjaro, Tanzania; and Ontario, California.

In 2021, Swissport International AG provided best-in-class airport ground services for some 97 million airline passengers (pre-Covid 2019: 265 million) and handled roughly 5.1 million tons of air freight (2019: 4.6 million) at over 100 cargo warehouses worldwide. Several of its warehouses have been certified for pharmaceutical logistics by IATA's CEIV Pharma and by the British MHRA. The world's leader in airport ground services and air cargo handling, with currently around 48,000 employees, was active at 285 airports in 45 countries on six continents at the end of December 2021.
