SWISSPORT WINS LOGANAIR AND VUELING AT HEATHROW

As part of its ongoing commitment to delivering exceptional service and expanding its footprint in London and the south, Swissport is thrilled to welcome Loganair and Vueling to its portfolio of esteemed airline customers at Heathrow airport.

Swissport has commenced services for Loganair and Vueling to provide airport ground services at Heathrow airport. The new contracts with the two carriers cover passenger services and ramp handling.

Loganair is the UK's largest regional airline and the contract to deliver its Terminal 2 operations marks an expansion of the existing collaboration between Swissport and the airline. Vueling, one of Europe's leading low-cost carriers, is a new entrant to Heathrow's Terminal 4, where it will offer daily flights to Paris-Orly and Barcelona.

Karen Cox, CEO for Swissport UK & Ireland, says: "We are delighted and proud that two brands at the heart of UK and European travel have put their trust in Swissport to safely and effectively deliver for them and for their passengers. At Swissport, we are passionate about becoming the service partner of choice at Heathrow airport and this is another important milestone on that journey."

Loganair's Head of Airports, Caroline Tunney, said: "We are excited to start a new chapter at Heathrow working with Swissport. They are a great bunch of people down there and we look forward to establishing a long-standing partnership of delivering for our customers."

In addition to airport ground services and aircraft cleaning, Swissport offers air cargo handling to more than 33 airline customers. Last year, the company served over 1.3 million passengers, and handled nearly 265,000 tons of air cargo at London's busiest airport, with a workforce of some 740 dedicated aviation professionals.

In 2023, Swissport International AG provided best-in-class airport ground services for some 232 million airline passengers (2022: 186 million) and handled roughly 4.7 million tons of air freight (2022: 4.8 million) at 115 air cargo centers worldwide. Several of its warehouses have been certified for pharmaceutical logistics by IATA's CEIV Pharma and by the British MHRA. At the end of December 2023, the world's leader in airport ground services and air cargo handling, with currently around 60,000 employees, was active at 286 airports in 44 countries on six continents.
